And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry." But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?' So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God." Luke 12:16-21

MY GREATNESS IS CONNECTED TO MY SERVING.

1. SERVING ISN'T SOMETHING WE DO; IT'S WHO WE ARE.

2. SERVING OTHERS REQUIRES JUST ONE ABILITY: AVAILABILITY.

3. SERVING OTHERS IS REWARDING BOTH INTRINSICALLY AND EXTRINSICALLY.
